POST – TONSILLECTOMY INSTRUCTIONS

PATIENT TEACHING

- 1. Drink plenty of fluids (32-64 ounces a day)
- 2. Eat a soft diet for 2 weeks
- 3. Take only prescribed medication for pain
- 4. Gargle with salt water 2 X a day. (1 teaspoon of salt in a large glass of water)
- 5. Call the doctor if there is a temperature greater than 102 degrees, if there is bleeding noticed or if any other problem persists
- 6. Use a humidifier
- 7. Chew gum to help keep the throat moist
- 8. DO NOT take aspirin, Motrin, Advil or Aleve
- 9. DO NOT engage in strenuous activities for 2 weeks.
- 10. DO NOT go to work or school for 2 weeks following surgery. If you continue with pain medication, you may be out longer than 2 weeks.
